_____ \$50.00 for 10 show tickets. Each student is *required* to sell 10 tickets to their show (a maximum of 20 tickets required to sell per production per family). Tickets will be available from the instructor at least one month before the first dress rehearsal. This fee is returned to you as you sell the tickets. This amount may be combined with the registration fee in the same check.

Code Of Conduct

RESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOR: Use of self-control in your actions and language. Abide by the dress code. Please be courteous in speech and action to other students and adults. Honor those around you by respecting them, encouraging them and avoiding words or actions that would be harmful. Including but not limited to gossip, slander, etc.

MUTUAL RESPECT: Treat yourself, others, and property with care and consideration. Abide by the dress code.

COOPERATION WITH OTHERS: Listen and work together. When conflict arises it should be privately discussed immediately between the two pertaining individuals. If the matter is not resolved, the next stage is for the two individuals to meet immediately with the teacher or assistant teacher. If there is no resolution, then the matter will be taken to the board. Please encourage one another to handle issues discreetly and immediately so that we don't become stumbling blocks to one another.

DATING/COURTING: If you are in a theatre class, starting a dating relationship/courtship between cast members is not permitted for the duration of the semester. If you are already in such a relationship, please tell the directing staff before casting begins. The arts are fraught with emotion, and relationships between cast members can create even more havoc. After the show is over, you are free to begin those new relationships. If you break this policy, the directing staff reserves the right to ask you to step down. That's how important we think this is. All's fair in love and drama.

SELF-CONTROL: Maintaining integrity inside and outside of classes and shows. MoezArt reserves the right to expel a student for behaviors that are not in line with God's standards, are potentially harmful to the student or negatively influential to fellow students. This includes, but not limited to, sexual activity (hetero and/or homo), taking of drugs and drinking of alcohol.

PERSONAL & ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE: Put forth your best effort in whatever you attempt. Adults and students will be positive representatives of Christ with modest appearance and abiding by "host" rules. In the arts this means demonstrating the following characteristics:

Directability—The willingness to be directed, try new things, trust the directors decisions and step out of your comfort zone. An attitude that says, "I will do whatever it takes to be successful and to grow as an artist."

Passion—A love of the arts and a desire to honor God with the talents and abilities He has given you. This is demonstrated by putting your heart and soul into what you do, knowing that you do it not for the praise of man but for the glory of God.

Self-Discipline—Making a commitment to do the best job you can do regardless of the circumstances or cost to yourself.

Integrity—Interacting with authority and your peers with honesty. Following through with your personal responsibilities for the good of the group.

Humility—We need to regard ourselves with sound judgment. "True humility means having an accurate view of ourselves, thinking we're no more or less than we are. We must know our strengths. We must know our weaknesses. We must know what we're good at, and accept what we're not good at." - *The Heart of the Artist* by Rory Noland.
